Everyone starts this class with a 100! It's up to you to keep it!

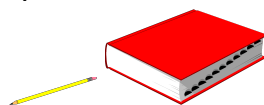

Class Grade:

Class Grade is based on class preparedness and participation, completing the Do Now upon arrival, and working till the bell. Tardiness and absences may also affect this grade especially if class work is not made up and submitted timely!

Homework assignment:

Homework will be given as and when necessary to reinforce classwork. To receive full credit, homework MUST be completed and turned by the due date in the assigned tray at the beginning of class. Sometimes the submission of papers/projects i.e. meeting deadlines and dues dates is a homework grade! Late work will not be accepted unless there is a valid and justified reason. If absent, you are responsible to ask for what you missed. ***You don't ask, I don't tell!*** All work must be made up timely, meaning if you are absent 1 school day, you get one school day to submit the work. If not, you lose the grade..

Remember! Your individual effort at completing assignments correlates to your success on quizzes and tests.

It is very important to hand in all work titled with your name, period and date of the given assignment! Work that is turned in without a name will not be considered.

Lab/Group Activities:

You will be given work to complete in groups. Everyone must participate, share the activity and display good teamwork! Work must be completed and submitted on time. I do not accept late work and a zero will result.

Lab-work is a very important part of Science. All students MUST obey and follow the lab safety rules and directions. If a student does not work at all, he/she will lose class grades for that day!.

Quizzes:

Quizzes will be given every week with a minimum of two day's notice. One quizz each marking period will be an "open notebook/binder".

Tests:

A test will be taken approximately every two weeks with a minimum of four day's notice. Test questions response may be in the format of short answer, essay, multiple-choice, draw and label diagrams, or solve in detail. Be present, prepared and attempt all the test questions. I will give partial credit for any correct response.

Midterms/Finals:

You will be required to complete a midterm and/or final exam for 10 %. grade late January and early June..

Extra Credit:

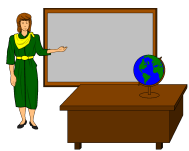
