Dear Parents/Guardians,

South Amboy Public Schools will be administering the mandatory Start Strong assessment the week of October 3 – 7. The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) notified districts that the New Jersey Start Strong will be administered as part of the overall Statewide assessment system. The Start Strong assessments are intentionally brief, designed to maximize instructional time and provide data to teachers and school leaders based on the prior year academic standards. Therefore, no special preparation for testing is necessary. This information was provided on our website.

Students in grades 7th who are enrolled in Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II will take the subject-level Mathematics *Start Strong* exam.

 Each assessment will be administered in approximately 45-60 minutes in the classroom during the week of October 3-5, 2022. Start Strong includes the same accessibility features and accommodations as the NJSLA.
